### **Entries**

All classes will be pre entry via [www.globalentriesonline.com.au](http://www.globalentriesonline.com.au) and **MUST BE PREPAID** before close of entries or names will be removed from draw.

Horse/Rider combinations may only start in 1 division of each height, e.g. A, B or C, not both or all and are limited to 2 classes per horse.

**Horses starting in classes 1 & 2 are not eligible to start on Saturday or Sunday of this event.**

### **Local Champions**

Please mark your entry "Yes" to the "LOCAL RIDER" question if you wish to be considered for local championship. Rider must PERMANENTLY RESIDE within 60km of Maitland Showground (Blomfield Street) according to Google directions map and not have competed C Grade or higher. Competitors that have competed C Grade or higher can still compete for placings but not be eligible for Local Champion award. Points for placings will be allocated for all classes with the higher classes points of higher value, e.g. win in 85cm and 95cm is worth more points than win in 75cm and 85cm.

Non-local riders may compete for placings but will not be eligible for Local Champion awards.

**All classes will be run under FEI/EA rules.**

All classes will be pre entry via [www.globalentriesonline.com.au](http://www.globalentriesonline.com.au) and **MUST BE PREPAID** before close of entries or names will be removed from draw. Although this event does not require 'immediate payment', the event organisers request that you chose classes carefully and should you choose to not attend, scratch your entries IMMEDIATELY or inform the committee. Entries NOT PAID by close of entries, will be automatically removed to provide spaces for other riders. We appreciate your cooperation in this regard, to facilitate the smooth running of the event.

For official classes, horses registration number must be submitted with entry, or entry will not be accepted. There will be a \$5 fee for any changes made after close of entries and may only be made by the previous day, i.e. any changes for Saturday must be made on Friday between 3pm and 4pm and changes for Sunday must be made on Saturday between 3pm and 4pm. **This policy will be strictly adhered to with NO EXCEPTIONS.** In the event of wet weather, only if event or part of event is cancelled, will a percentage of entries be refunded. There will be NO REFUNDS after close of entries unless veterinary or doctors certificate is provided.

**Juniors** - From the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 12 until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 18. Juniors can compete in Junior competitions and open classes on the same horse, but not more than one division within a class.

**Young Riders** - From the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 21.

**Amateurs** - Must be 21 years of age or older, must never have competed in an Olympic Games or WEG in either Jumping or Eventing, must never have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders qualifying round, must not have competed in section 1 and 2 at a Royal Show in Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Adelaide or Perth in the past 2 years, must never have competed in a 4\* 3 Day Event who have competed or will compete in a class higher than the height of the designated "Amateur Class" at the same show, Horses that have competed in classes above 1.20m at the same show will be excluded from the Amateur classes.

**NOTE: Amateur classes at this show may include fences of 1.20m in height.**

**Six Bar** – Will commence at 5pm on Saturday. Riders **MUST** be ready on time for commencement of this class.

**Country Champions Pointscore** - For Junior, Young Rider, Amateur & Senior Horse/Rider combinations. Junior (Class 4C & 9C), Young Rider (6B & 12B) and Amateur Champions (4B & 9B) will be decided over their two classes on Saturday & Sunday, with Sunday's classes accruing more points. Seniors can gain points from any classes (best 3 results counted) except Junior, Young Rider & Amateur, i.e. classes 4A, 5, 6A, 7, 8, 9A, 10A, 11 and 12, with the higher classes accruing more points, i.e. A & B class worth more points than D Grade.

**Dress Rule** - Summer Dress will apply, except for Championships Classes, when coats will be worn at the discretion of the Committee.

**TIMBER STALLS** - must be booked and paid with entries. The stalls are timber on 3 sides with an open gate for the front side and have a dirt floor. These stalls are suitable for overnight stay and are 10' x 9'. Bedding can be purchased with entries if preferred. There are some double sized stalls available but numbers are limited.

**STABLES** - must be booked via [www.globalentriesonline.com](http://www.globalentriesonline.com) and require immediate payment. Numbers are limited. If cancelled before close of entries, refunds will be paid. Stables are brick and are 12' x 12'. Stables will include a standard amount of bedding however extra bedding can be purchased with booking.
