## Friday Entries

- All classes will be pre entry via [www.globalentriesonline.com.au](http://www.globalentriesonline.com.au) and **MUST BE PAID FOR WITHIN 40 MINUTES** or the entry will automatically be removed from the system.
- Horses may only start in 1 division of each height, e.g. A, B or C, not both or all, and are limited to 2 consecutive heights per horse.
- **Horses starting in classes 1 & 2 are not eligible to start on Saturday or Sunday of this event.**

## Local Champions

Please mark your entry "Yes" to the "LOCAL RIDER" question if you wish to be considered for local championship. Rider must PERMANENTLY RESIDE within 60km of Maitland Showground (Blomfield Street) according to Google directions map and have never competed 1.20m (C Grade) or higher. Competitors that have competed C Grade or higher and non-local riders can still compete for placings, but not be eligible for Local Champion award. Points for placings will be allocated for all classes with the higher classes points of higher value, e.g. win in 85cm and 95cm is worth more points than win in 75cm and 85cm.

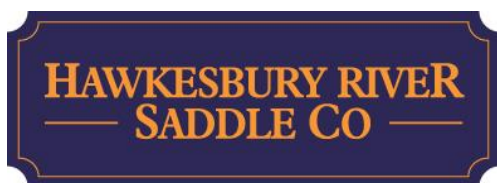

- **All classes will be run under FEI/EA rules.**
- All classes will be pre entry via [www.globalentriesonline.com.au](http://www.globalentriesonline.com.au) and **MUST BE PAID WITHIN 40 MINUTES** or the system will delete your entry. If you wish to scratch your entry prior to close of entries (9pm 10/02/14) email the committee ([entries@hvsjc.com.au](mailto:entries@hvsjc.com.au)) and you will be refunded in full. We ask that you DO NOT remove your own entries if there are waiting lists. We appreciate your cooperation in this regard, to facilitate the smooth running of the event.
- **There will be NO REFUNDS after close of entries unless veterinary or doctors certificate is provided.**
- There will be a **\$5 fee** for any changes made after close of entries and may only be made by the previous day, i.e. any changes for Saturday must be made on Friday between 3pm and 4pm and changes for Sunday must be made on Saturday between 3pm and 4pm. **This policy will be strictly adhered to with NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- In the event of wet weather, only if event or part of event is cancelled, will a percentage of entries be refunded.
- The EA Hot Weather Policy will be adhered to.
- For official classes, horses registration number and riders EA number must be submitted with entry, or entry will be removed. Any horses or riders found to be unregistered after the event may receive **HEAVY FINES** from Equestrian Australia of up to \$500. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that they and their horses are registered and hold current jumping cards.
- Horses may only start in 1 division of each height, e.g. A, B or C, not both or all, and are limited to 2 classes each day per horse. With the exception of Class 7 – Open 6-bar, which may be entered as a 3<sup>rd</sup> class.
- **Horses starting in classes 1 & 2 are not eligible to start on Saturday or Sunday of this event.**
- **Juniors** - From the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 12 until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 18. Juniors can compete in Junior competitions and open classes on the same horse, but not more than one division within a class. **Note:** Juniors under the age of 12 are eligible to compete on Friday.
- **Young Riders** - From the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 21.
- **Amateurs** - Must be 21 years of age or older, must never have competed in an Olympic Games or WEG in either Jumping or Eventing, must never have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders qualifying round, must not have competed in section 1 and 2 at a Royal Show in Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Adelaide or Perth in the past 2 years , must never have competed in a 4\* 3 Day Event, may not compete in an Amateur class if they compete in a class higher than 1.20m at that show, may not compete in an Amateur class on a horse that will compete in any class higher than 1.20m at that show.
- **Six Bar** – Will commence at approx. 3:00pm on Saturday. Riders **MUST** be ready on time for commencement of this class.
- **Hunter Region Champions Pointscore** - For Junior, Young Rider, Amateur & Senior Horse/Rider combinations. Junior (Class 4C & 9B), Young Rider (6B & 12B) and Amateur Champions (4B & 10) will be decided over their two classes on Saturday & Sunday, with Sunday's classes accruing more points. Seniors can gain points from **ANY CLASSES** (best 3 results counted) except Junior, Young Rider & Amateur, i.e. classes 4A, 5, 6A, 7, 8, 9A, 12A and 13, with the higher classes accruing more points, eg. 1.35 class worth more points than 1.05 class.  
PLEASE NOTE: Senior Champion is NOT just points from classes 8 & 11.
- **Most Successful Thoroughbred Award** – to be eligible for this award horses **MUST be ASB registered** and owners/riders to prove this on request. This award is specifically aimed at performance careers for horses bred for racing. Thoroughbreds can gain points from **ANY CLASSES** (best 2 results counted from Saturday and Sunday) with the higher classes accruing more points, eg. 1.35 class worth more points than 1.05 class.

- **Dress Rule** - Summer Dress will apply, except for Championships Classes, when coats will be worn at the discretion of the Committee.
- **TIMBER STALLS** - must be booked and paid with entries. The stalls are timber on 3 sides with an open gate for the front side and have a dirt floor. These stalls are suitable for overnight stay and are 10' x 9'. Bedding can be purchased with entries if preferred. There are some double sized stalls available but numbers are limited.
- **STABLES** - must be booked and paid with entries. Numbers are limited. If cancelled before close of entries, refunds will be paid. Stables are brick and are 12' x 12'. Stables will include a standard amount of bedding however extra bedding can be purchased with booking.
